

The following information is about proficiency in foreign language for Masters and Doctoral Degrees of the Postgraduate Program in Movement Sciences.

Article 1 - In compliance with the provisions of item II of Article 3 of the Regulation of the Postgraduate Program in Movement Sciences, for the Masters and Doctoral Degrees, candidates must present proof of English proficiency at enrollment.

Article 2 – Students should demonstrate proficiency in one of the following exams: PRE-TOEFL (PRE - Test of English as a Foreign Language) with a score ≥ 389 points; ITP-TOEFL (International Testing Program - Test of English as a Foreign Language) with scores ≥ 527 points; TOEFL-iBT (Test of English as a Foreign Language - internet-Based Test) with score ≥ 78 points; IELTS (International English Language Testing System) with a score of 6 or higher; TOEIC (Test of English for International Communication) with score of 600 points or higher.

Paragraph 1: The validity periods of each test will be considered.

Article 3 - Candidates will not need to demonstrate proficiency in a foreign language at enrollment if:

I - Residence, for a minimum period of six months, in a country whose official language is required;

II - Proficiency obtained for the Masters Degree, in a program recognized by CAPES, for candidates enrolling in Doctoral Degree.

Article 4 - The written test of proficiency in Portuguese for foreign students coming from countries of another official language, other than Portuguese, will be applied by a specially appointed Commission, by the Program Board, for this purpose.

Paragraph 1 - Foreign students who have passed a Portuguese language test applied by the Brazilian Embassy will be exempt from performing the test specified in this article.

Paragraph 2 - The approval in the proficiency test in Portuguese must integrate the documentation request for the Qualification Exam.
