

Rules and Regulations for Admission in the Doctoral Program (Kinesiology)

Criteria for admission in the Doctoral Program and Transfer to the Doctoral Program:

Candidates who hold Masters degree or who are applying for transfer from the Masters Program to the Doctoral Program in Kinesiology must present at the enrollment:

1. Application presented to the Director of the Institute of Biosciences, Rio Claro campus, indicating the Program, Degree, Area of Concentration, Research Line and the intended advisor;
2. Letter of acceptance of the advisor with justification based on the scientific and cultural quality of the candidate, and on the quality and relevance of the research project compatible with the grade of the Postgraduate Program according to CAPES;
3. Research project to be developed in the Doctoral Program, adequate to the research line of the Postgraduate Program, with the consent of the intended advisor;
4. Manuscript accepted for publication or published as main author during the last three years, in a journal classified at least as B1 according to CAPES's Qualis classification (at the time of acceptance and / or publication), or book or chapter of a book published without link to events, as main author, in the last three years, in a publishing company with tradition in the area of research and editorial board. The publication of book and chapter of book should present link with the area of concentration and line of research;
5. Copy of the diploma or certificate of completion from college and/or postgraduate program *stricto sensu*;
6. *Curriculum vitae* "Plataforma Lattes" - full version (documented);
7. Copy of identity card or equivalent document, CPF and Electoral Title;
8. Two 3x4 photos;
9. Proficiency in foreign language, according to Normative Instruction.

Note: Candidates who have completed the Masters Program in the Postgraduate Program in Kinesiology do not need to pay the registration fee.

Candidates for the Direct Doctorate Program, in addition to the item mentioned above, must submit a certificate of doctoral fellowship granted.

The evaluation of the candidate's application to the Doctoral Program will be carried out by the Program Board, taking into account the justification of the advisor, the opinion of the professor indicated and the documentation presented.
